**National Teacher's Pension Strike Action by the NUT and ATL
taking place on 30th June 2011.**

Dear Parent and Carers

We have been advised by the City Council that teachers belonging to the NUT and ATL unions are proposing to take strike action on **Thursday 30th June 2011** in response to the Coalition Governments plans to make changes to the Teacher's Pension Scheme.

Having carefully considered the position in our school (including the operational and health and safety implications), school will remain open for most classes, though some classes will be affected:

- Nursery
- Reception Fir
- Reception Elm
- Y1 Cherry
- Y1 Apple
- Yr3 Holly
- Yr4 Rowan
- 6 Ash

Pupils in these classes should not attend school on the **30th June 2011**. This action is not taken lightly by teachers.

If your child has a paid school meal you will need to deduct £1.85 next week if they are not in on Thursday. The cost of the meals will only be £7.40.
