Pupil Teacher Assessment - Teacher assessments are awarded for Reading, Writing and Mathematics. Teachers are not permitted to give an award of working at greater depth for these subjects with the exception of writing.

Test Results - The national curriculum tests at the end of key stage 2 (KS2) (often referred to as SATs) are administered in Mathematics, English reading and English grammar punctuation and spelling.
