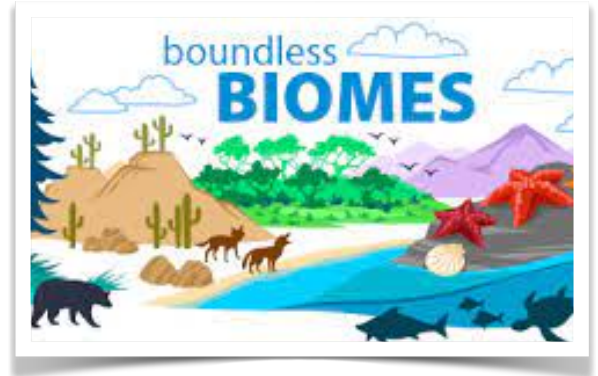


Around The World with Year 3

Geography.

This half term, the children will be learning about climate zones and the different biomes that exist in these climate zones. We will be learning about biomes in our literacy lessons, however in our theme lessons we will be focusing on human and physical features of Europe and then human and physical features of North America. The children will continue to apply knowledge of the new vocabulary in different contexts. We will be using technology to show the children's understanding such as iMovie and Clips. Excitingly we will also learn a little bit more about an environmental core value champion Anita Rani who has campaigned for the reduction of plastics in the ocean. Reducing plastics in the ocean will be the key learning for our climate change project at the end of the half term. We want children to become informed about current environmental issues and for them to be confident to talk, discuss and find out more for themselves. We will continue to develop the children's Oracy skills which is speaking clearly and engaging the audience
