The Tudors

This half term we will continue to learn all about the Tudors. For this half term's homework project, we want you to explore the question:
"Who do you think was the greatest Tudor monarch, and why?"

Choose one of the tasks below to complete at home. Each task is a different level of challenge – pick one that suits you best.



GOLD

Design and Build a Tudor Throne or Crown

For a more hands-on challenge, create a **model of** a **Tudor throne or crown** fit for the monarch you believe was the greatest.

Throne: Use cardboard, recycled materials, or wood to design and build a **Tudor-style throne**. Think about how the throne would reflect the monarch's personality (e.g., Henry VIII's throne might be grand and powerful, while Elizabeth I's might be more elegant and regal).

Crown: Design and make a Tudor crown using craft materials such as cardboard, foil, gems, and fabric. Research what Tudor crowns looked like and try to make yours historically accurate.

SILVER

Tudor Monarch Top Trumps Cards

Research at least three Tudor monarchs and Create a set of Top Trumps cards.

Your cards should include:

- A picture of each monarch
- Key facts about their reign (e.g., years ruled, major events, achievements)
- A score for different categories, such as:
- -Leadership Skills
- -Impact on England
- -Popularity

You can make the cards by hand or digitally using an app like keynote or PicCollage.

BRONZE

Create a Tudor Monarch Fact File

Create a **fact file** about one of the Tudor monarchs (Henry VII, Henry VIII, Mary I, or Elizabeth I).

Your fact file should include:

- Key dates and events during their reign
- Important achievements or decisions they made
- A picture of the monarch (drawn or printed)

You can present your fact file as a poster, booklet, or digital document.
