What is ‘Conkers’ Enhanced Resource Provision (ERP)?

‘Conkers’ Enhanced Resource Provision (ERP) is a specialist unit within a mainstream school that provides targeted support for pupils with complex communication and interaction difficulties.

The children have an EHCP that outlines specific needs.



Our Purpose

The ERP exists to:

-  **Provide a personalised learning experience** tailored to each child's unique strengths and needs.
-  **Offer access to specialist staff,** resources, and strategies in a supportive environment.
-  **Support inclusion** by enabling children to be part of the wider school community, with the right support in place.
-  **Develop communication, independence, and social skills** alongside academic progress.
-  **Work in partnership with families** and professionals to create a consistent, nurturing approach.



Who Is It For?

Children with Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs) who require a higher level of support than a mainstream setting typically offers — but who would benefit from being part of a mainstream school community.

Our Vision

We aim to support every child's individual needs through tailored resources, targeted interventions, and a nurturing environment.



Resources & Equipment

To enhance learning and development, we are investing in:

- Sensory Circuit & Multi-Sensory Equipment
For physical and sensory regulation and engagement.
- Mud Kitchen (currently being installed)
A hands-on space to explore textures and imaginative play.
- Specialist Equipment
Includes weighted vests, bespoke socks, and sensory snacks.
- Learning Subscriptions
 - Equals curriculum subscription
 - Resources for communication, independence, and life skills



Interventions & Support

We offer a range of **tailored interventions**, such as:

- **Lego Therapy**
- **Intensive Interaction** (adults working alongside children)
- **Attention Autism**
- **Total Communication Approach** (focused on vocabulary and environment)
- **Turn-Taking Interventions**
- **Speech & Language – Gestalt Language Processing**

We monitor these closely and provide feedback.



Staff Training (CPD)

Our specialist team is regularly trained in:

- Autism strategies
- Sensory processing
- Speech and language development
- PDA (Pathological Demand Avoidance)
- Thrive Approach
- Tac Pac (physical-sensory interaction)





NHS & External Support

We work closely with external professionals, such as:

- **Speech & Language Therapists (SALT)**
- **LA hub**
- **Occupational Therapists (OT)**
- **CCT**
- **NHS packages**

Referrals and follow-up reviews are in place to ensure continuity.



Assessment & Curriculum

We use a **broad, balanced and non-linear curriculum** tailored to each child's progress, including:

- **Equals Curriculum** linked closely with the **Engagement Model**
- **Evidence for Learning**
 - Staff capture photos, notes and videos to show progress.
 - Parents can access this evidence and celebrate milestones at home at parents evening, annual reviews
